







6.- IDANHA A VELHA (Portugal, 2012)

For my teaching visit in Castelo Branco, I could go to Idanha-a-Velha, in Idanha-a-Nova, where I saw a very small village, with a huge history.

In this traditional valley, it was founded as the Roman city of Igaeditânia (Egitania). They built a cathedral and made Idanha their regional capital. Today a small population of shepherds and farmers live amid this ruins, with some excellents inscriptions in stones.

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
