

3.- CROSS BATH & WELLS (England, 2016)

These pictures are part of some research carried out in March 2016 at Bath Spa University, which included an Erasmus visit too. The purpose of the stay was to study the shared cultural heritage, at a Thermal Historical Town and Site. In this way, both images are inspired in the natural spring water as a subject of our study.
