





Motivation: To “enhance the capacity of 25 EDUCATORS and 15 adult ORGANIZATIONS in their support for 150 *SENIORS to remain active while ageing*”,

3 specific objectives:

- 1: Improve the level of skills of 25 EDUCATORS to adequately contribute to seniors education and development,
- 2: Facilitate access of 150 SENIORS to informal learning opportunities and exchanges of experiences
- 3: Enhance the capacity of 15 ADULT ORGANIZATIONS to appropriately valorize seniors



- ❑ Adult organizations working with seniors in all kinds of education and social care system.



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
